Route description to BIMHUIS Amsterdam

By public transport

BIMHUIS Amsterdam is easy to reach by public transportation. From train station 'Amsterdam Centraal' (Amsterdam Central Station) it's a 10-minute walk to BIMHUIS Amsterdam or use tram transport to reduce walking time. In addition, you can easily park your bike here, both outside and inside the covered bike shed.

By tram

To reach BIMHUIS Amsterdam from 'Amsterdam Centraal' by tram, take tram 26 to 'IJburg' and exit the first stop at "Muziekgebouw / BIMHUIS". The tram between the central station and BIMHUIS Amsterdam rides every 10 minutes.

By car

Coming from Utrecht/Amersfoort

Coming from the direction of Utrecht A2 and Amersfoort A1 follow the A10 direction Zaanstad until exit S114 (Centrum/Zeeburg/Artis). After that follow the route as indicated on the directions from Den Haag / Schiphol, see below.

Coming from Zaandam

Take the Zeeburgertunnel and exit S114 (Centrum/Zeeburg/Artis). Continue as indicated below.

Coming from Den Haag/Schiphol

From direction Den Haag/Schiphol you follow the A10. Take the exit S114 and turn left at the end of the exit. Go straight ahead into the Piet Heintunnel. Turn right at the traffic lights, direction Central Station. After the third traffic light (with the tunnel under the railway on your left side), take the second turn to the right, Piet Heingarage (this is the parking garage next to the BIMHUIS Amsterdam).

Parking

Park your car in the Piet Hein Garage, which is located under the BIMHUIS Amsterdam or at P+R Zeeburg.

Piet Hein Garage (Height, 2,10m)

Per 3 minutes: €0,25

Per day (maximum): €50

P+R Zeeburg, Zuiderzeeweg 46a

The nearest parking garage is P+R Zeeburg, Zuiderzeeweg 46a (€8.00 for 24 hours if you drive in before 10 am, including GVB return tickets for tram, bus and metro for you and your partner). From there, take tram 26 (towards 'Amsterdam Centraal'). It stops right in front of the BIMHUIS Amsterdam.
